President's Message

September 16 was a beautiful, sunny late summer day made better by good discussion and dining at the Volpe Barn as the Boston Post Board of Directors gathered for the quarterly meeting. Highlights of the meeting are as follows:

- At the September 11 Post meeting, Sustaining Member firm, Perini Management Services donated an additional \$12,500 toward the Wentworth Institute endowed scholarship. The BOD voted to match the Perini donation thereby increasing our support for engineering education. Many thanks to Perini and John Gerstenlauer, VP for their continued support of Post activities.
- Mark Anderson, Young Member Chair reminded all Sustaining Member firms to sign-up their designated young member. Mark is planning some upcoming Young Member events so keep an eye on the Bugle for details.
- Christen Sardano, Chair, reported that the Education and Outreach Committee had met and decided to continue Post sponsorship of many of the programs we have supported in the past. These include the Air Force and Seabees Construction Camps, Math Counts, robotics camps and science fairs. The BOD approved a \$12,000 budget to support these activities.
- SAME National is establishing a Continuing Education Advisory Committee to provide advice and assistance on continuing education programs for members. This group will also evaluate SAME's strategic partnerships with NSPE, IFMA, and CMAA. Pete Delano, Nobis Engineering, volunteered to be the Post representative on this National group.
- Neal Maxymillian, Chair of the Small Business Committee, reported the Committee has met and is actively planning a small business opportunity and networking event for February 2008. The exact format and timing are still be worked out but this popular event is sure to be a hit once again.
- As decided at the last BOD, Tom Follett has taken the lead on revising the Boston Post Constitution and By-Laws to more closely align with SAME National's templates. Tom presented his draft of the revisions to the BOD and Board members have until 1 October to provide Tom with any edits or comments. Once the documents are finalized, adoption of any revisions will be put to the Post membership for a vote.
