Lauren was especially excited to take what she learned about the design of dams and levees and apply it to her geometry class.
- Dan Strickland and his son represented the Algonquin Robotics team which the Post has sponsored for the past three years. They brought in two of their robots show the audience how the robots are constructed and what they can perform.

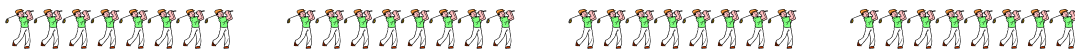
